Sample Eligible Expenses

For Catastrophic Injury or Illness



All requests must be submitted with a Fund Request Form and supporting documentation.

- Health insurance premiums for client
- COBRA premiums
- Hospital and doctors' fees not covered by insurance, including deductibles and copays; telephone and television rentals during hospitalizations
- Disposable medical equipment and supplies for the client, including catheters, pads and briefs, and medically needed over the counter drug store items
- Injury or illness-related medications and medication co-pays
- Home accessibility and modification expenses
- Medically necessary vehicle with handicap modifications; reasonable maintenance costs
- Home health care for client; hiring and paying caregivers
- Medically recommended rehabilitation therapy, including physical, occupational, activity-based, speech, and massage
- Medically necessary exercise equipment
- Treatments that are FDA approved or currently under FDA initial review and recommended by a medical professional (with some exceptions)
- Assistive technologies, such as computers and voice enhancers
- Medically necessary trained service or emotionally supportive animal, including food and veterinary care; if necessary, boarding during owner's treatment
- Transportation: local travel (one-day round trip) and long-distance travel (overnight or longer) for client and one caregiver to access treatment or for caregiver to visit hospitalized client
- Relocation expenses to access treatment
- Meals during medical travel or temporary relocation to access treatment
- Emergency assistance for living expenses (mortgage, rent, utilities)
- Other uninsured health care needs impacting client's injury or illness, such as dental and vision care that is required for treatment or the result of an accident or injury
- One telephone for client
- Burial expenses
- Fundraising expenses within reason
