Our free **National Tele-Support Network for Parents of Children with Visual Impairment** connects you with parents whose children have the same eye condition, so you share resources, experiences, strength and hope.

Tele-support groups meet by phone or online every week, and are facilitated by a Psychologist or Social Worker with input from professionals and experts in the field of blindness.

- Retinopathy of Prematurity/
 Familial Exudative Vitreo Retinopathy
- Leber Congenital Amaurosis
- Autism and Blindness

- Hermanski-Pudlak Syndrome (English and Spanish)

- CHARGE Syndrome

Our free **Teen Tele-support Groups** are for high school students who are visually impaired or blind. The group meets by phone to share experiences and discuss topics of interest.
