Access: Description (Teacher/Parent)

Access: Description (Student)

This module is an overview of description and why it is essential to providing access for individuals who are blind or have low vision. The module reviews description guidelines, discusses description laws, and explains the unique requirements for educational description. Many examples of description are included.

The student version explores the history of description and what laws promise them equal access to media. It contains interactive components to engage students as they learn.

The teacher/parent version is approved for ACVREP credit.



Sight-Reading Braille

These modules teach the basics of sight-reading braille. There are six parts that teach the braille alphabet, capitalization, basic punctuation, and numbers.

They are designed for students and adults who want to learn how to sight-read braille.

Teachers can earn 6 hours of ACVREP credit.

Let's Describe (English version) / Describamos (Spanish version)



This workshop provides educators and families with information and tools on audio description to make daily life more accessible to students/children who are blind or have low vision. The techniques are based on standards for adding audio description to recorded media. This workshop offers an overview of audio description guidelines and hands-on exercises to experience audio description creation.



Access: Working with Students

Who Are Blind Or Have Low Vision

DCMP's *Access: Working With Students Who Are Blind or Have Low Vision* module provides an overview and will touch on some of the most important aspects of educating students who have vision loss. The module includes resources for general education teachers to learn more on various topics.

This module is intended for teachers, staff, and administrators who work with students in the K-12 setting who are blind or have low vision. Participants who successfully complete the training may download and print a file issued by DCMP that verifies the completion of three hours of training.

This online module has been approved for 3 hours of ACVREP Credit.



Getting a Job! for Students Who Are Blind and Visually Impaired

This module was developed and designed for students who are blind or have low vision and the professionals who work with them. Focusing on the transition from school to work, the training offers a series of activities, supporting documents, and topical videos designed to help the job seeker prepare for the world of work. It features several role models who are blind or have low vision to guide students along the path to work.

This eLearning course can be completed in multiple sessions. Students can document their thoughts, lessons, and important papers in their own Career Planning Log. Completing all the activities and assignments will earn a student a "Verification of Completion" certificate. Participants will need to sign up for a free DCMP eLearner account.



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
