<u>GUIDE DOG</u> - Because people have varying needs, we offer a variety of free training options including on-campus residential, in-home delivery, flex (combining the benefits of on-campus and in-home options) and adaptive services including DeafBlind training.

ORIENTATION AND MOBILITY - O&M skills are crucial to becoming an independent traveler. Our free programs focus on how to use a white cane, maintaining orientation while traveling and overall safety. This one-on-one, week-long training is customized for introduction to O&M, brush-up, guide dog readiness, advanced, in-home and our newest program, Teen O&M.

TEEN SUMMER CAMP - This free program combines fun activities like ziplining and rock wall climbing with leadership skills training and meeting peers facing similar challenges. Campers receive a free HumanWare GPS to help increase their travel independence and spend a day with our guide dog mobility instructors and Leader Dogs in training to learn about living and working with a guide dog. Open to ages 16 and 17.
